

Exercise Your Right to VOTE!

If you are experiencing homelessness, you can (and should) register to vote!



You are eligible to vote in Alameda County if you are:

- A U.S. citizen
- A resident of Alameda County
- 18 years or older on Election Day (November 3, 2020)
- Not currently in prison or on parole for a felony conviction

The deadline to register to vote in the upcoming election is October 19, 2020

All you need to complete your voter registration is:

- A mailing address where you can receive your ballot
- Your residence address (even if it's an outside location)
- Either your social security number or California ID/CDL numbers



Verify or change your voter registration:

- If you are not sure you are registered to vote in Alameda County, check your status on the County Registrar's website <https://www.sos.ca.gov/elections/registration-status>



DID YOU KNOW?

- This year, **ALL registered voters in California will receive a Mail-In Ballot** sent to them before election day (November 3, 2020)
- You can either mail-in your ballot OR drop it off at an official ballot drop-box or at a Voting Center
- You can also vote in-person at one of Alameda County's Accessible Voting Centers
