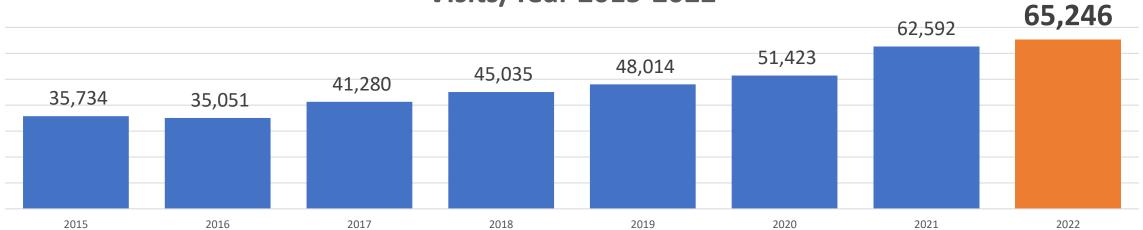

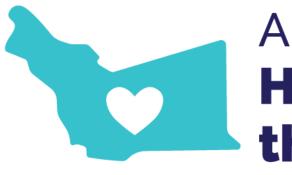


#### Key Takeaways for 2022:

#### **Continued growth of ACHCH services, visits and patients:**

- 11 Street Health Teams in full operation under ACHCH direction
  - 2,636 Patients 23,326 visits visits in 2022; Continued increase 2017-present
  - Large number of Nursing and Enabling visits by Street Health Teams
- ACHCH Shelter Health:
  - 1,167 patients in 2,731 visits
  - ACHCH COVID Services
    - No COVID testing provided 2022 (test kit distribution)
    - Reduced vaccinations in 2022
    - Most COVID response not reflected in UDS numbers (guidance, rapid response, supply distribution)
- Continued Expansion of *Enabling Services* 
  - TRUST and Street Health Teams: More CHW/Case Manager/Health Coach FTEs and services 24,058 enabling visits in 2021 vs. 18,765 visits in 2020
- **Increase in Behavioral Health visits** (psychiatry, psychology, LCSW, MFT and TRUST clinic)
